## WATER PRESSURE FLUCTUATIONS POSSIBLE!

Phase I of the Terrytown Water Project is nearing completion. We are anticipating receiving water from the City of Gering the week after Thanksgiving. During the connection process there might be minor water pressure fluctuations to the system while we balance the connections, but water pressure will be maintained at a safe level.

The City wants to remind the residents of Terrytown that the water supply from Gering will contain minor amounts of chlorine and fluoride.

## EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2018

### NEW RATES FOR WATER & SEWER UTILITIES and NEW STORM WATER SURCHARGE

Rates for water and sewer will be as follows:

Water — \$32.34 + tax

Sewer — \$42.00 + tax

Residents of Sanitary and Improvement District No. 2 will continue to pay the additional \$15.00 per month for operation and maintenance (O&M Fees) for the sanitary sewer mains through which the City supplies sanitary sewer services.

Rates for metered locations shall be as follows:

Water — \$3.09 per 1,000 gallons

Sewer — \$3.86 per 1,000 gallons

An additional \$1.25 per month surcharge to all occupied or unoccupied dwellings with water and sewer service for storm water regulatory requirements and the use, upkeep and maintenance of the City's storm water collection system.

### Fire Protection Services



The Scottsbluff Rural Fire Department covers over 200 square miles of Scotts Bluff County including 24 square miles in Sioux County and Terrytown. Our station is located at 1717 East 15th Street in Scottsbluff which has us near the center of our protection district. We are governed by five members of the Scottsbluff Rural Fire Protection District Board of Directors.

Our fleet of apparatus consists of 2 Engines, 2 Tankers, 4 Grass Rigs and 1 Engine/Tanker combination truck. We are staff by a total of 24 volunteer firefighters who range in age from 18 to 70. We train weekly on Tuesday nights in addition to training on weekends throughout the month. Several of our volunteers are also state certified as Firefighter I Level and Hazardous Material Operations Level.
