UPDATE ON CITY WATER PROJECT



The City of Terrytown is waiting for USDA authorization to bid “Phase I-Water Connection to the City of Gering” of the City of Terrytown Water Project. Once USDA authorizes the project, the City will advertise and receive bids to connect to the City of Gering’s water system. The City anticipates this bid process will be complete early this spring and construction will be

complete by late summer or early fall. The City will then bid “Phase II-Meter Installation” this summer with construction of Phase II beginning late summer or early fall. The City anticipates Phase II will be complete by early summer of 2018. The City of Terrytown thanks everyone for their patience during this project.

POLICY FOR PROCESSING LATE CHARGES AND DELINQUENT PAYMENTS

1. City customer’s statements will be mailed out the last week of the month.
2. Payments are due on the 15th of the month, either delivered in person or postmarked by the 15th.
3. Late charges of 10% will be assessed between the 16th and 18th of the month. Delinquent letters will be mailed at that time.
4. Delinquent payments are due seven (7) days from date of delinquent letters.
5. Arrangements for payment can be made with the City Office to avoid water shut-offs, however, payment must be made no later than the end of the month.
6. Once water is turned off, payment must be made in full including the reconnection fee of \$100.00 during business hours (7:30 a.m.-3:30 p.m.). After business hours, the reconnection fee is \$130.00.
7. All charges including delinquent late fee must be paid by the end of the month.
8. There will be no exceptions, everyone will be treated the same.
