

ORDINANCE NO. 482

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF TERRYTOWN, NEBRASKA AMENDING AND REPLACING IN ITS ENTIRETY CHAPTER 7, SECTION 205 DEALING WITH INSTALLATION, EXPENSE, AND TAPPING OF WATER MAINS WITHIN THE CITY, PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN PAMPHLET FORM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TERRYTOWN, NEBRASKA:

Section 1. Chapter 7, Section 205 of the Terrytown Municipal Code is amended as follows:

A7-205 INSTALLATION, EXPENSE, TAP FEE, REQUIREMENT OF LICENSED PLUMBER OR LICENSED CONTRACTOR

A. Each customer shall pay the cost of tapping the City's water main, providing and installing the meter and providing fixtures and labor up to and including the stop box at his or her lot line. No person other than a licensed plumber or licensed contractor shall tap the main. A copy of the license shall be provided to City utility superintendent prior to any work occurring. The customer shall pay a tap fee and connection fee as set forth by resolution of the City Council and kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk prior to tapping any mains belonging to the City.

B. Additionally, the customer shall, at their own expense, bring water service from the City's main up to and upon their own premises and shall employ a licensed plumber or licensed contractor to install water service to the place of dispersal. A copy of the license shall be provided to City utility superintendent prior to any work occurring.

C. Nonresidents shall pay such tap fees and connection fees as set forth by resolution of the City Council and kept on file in the Office of the City Clerk prior to tapping any mains belonging to the City. The extension of City commercial mains into unsupplied territories may be made by means of water extension districts.

D. If City commercial mains are not laid along the street abutting applicant's property and if a water main district is not created or extended, the applicant may, at their own expense and under the approval and direction of the City, hire a licensed plumber or licensed contractor and pay the costs of trenching, pipe installation, labor, and attachments necessary to bring water services from the nearest commercial main to the applicant's premises."

Section 2. All other ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed. Provided, however, this ordinance shall not be construed to effect any rights, or duties existing at the time this ordinance becomes effective.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective upon its passage and approval by law, and

publication shall be in pamphlet form.
