### Step 1. Enroll Online

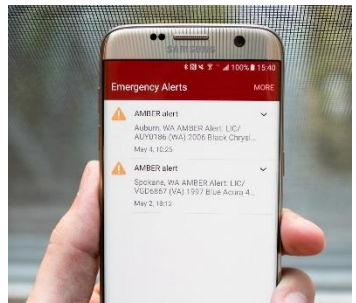
Go to [www.panhandlealert.org](http://www.panhandlealert.org) and enter the required information and how you want to be reached

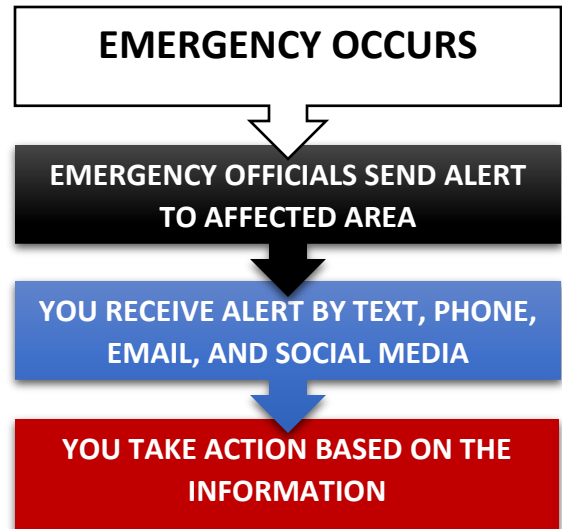


## EMERGENCY ALERTS AND NOTIFICATIONS

### What is Panhandle Alert?

**Panhandle Alert** is the region's official emergency notification system. **Panhandle Alert** is a FREE service that allows you to sign up online to receive customized alerts by text message, email, voice message and on social media (Facebook and Twitter).

### What Types of Alerts Will I Receive?

**EMERGENCY ALERTS** are sent when there is a significant risk to life or property at any time of the day or night. **COMMUNITY NOTIFICATIONS** are customizable and are only sent during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m. They include notifications about severe weather, safety, health, utility service disruptions, major traffic incidents, changes in government services due to weather or holidays, etc.
