### What is Panhandle Alert?

Panhandle Alert is the region's official emergency notification system. Panhandle Alert is a FREE service that allows you to sign up online to receive customized alerts by text message, email, voice message and on social media (Facebook and Twitter).

# What Types of Alerts Will I Receive?

emergency alerts are sent when there is a significant risk to life or property at any time of the day or night.

COMMUNITY NOTIFICATIONS are customizable and are only sent during the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 p.m.

They include notifications about severe weather, safety, health, utility service disruptions, major traffic incidents, changes in government services due to weather or holidays, etc.
